BELVIDERE TOWNSHIP, BOONE CO., IL-----Located on TOWNLINE ROAD- $\frac{1}{2}$ mile East of BELOIT ROAD.. Start West side--Rows--South to North--This Cemetery has been cleaned up, some stones reset in the front row as their original place cannot be determined.
